

Declaration of Conformity with the Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directives 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU

VOIPAC TECHNOLOGIES s.r.o. (Voipac) hereby declares that all Voipac products are in compliance with the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) Directive 2011/65/EU and the Council of 8 June 2011, and with the later Directive 2015/863/EU and the Council of 31 March 2015 (amending Annex II which adds 4 phthalates to the list of restricted substances).

Restricted substances and maximum concentration values (MCV) tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials (as per Annex II of 2015/863/EU directive) are:

- Lead (Pb) (0.1 %)
- Mercury (Hg) (0.1 %)
- Cadmium (Cd) (0.01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
- Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)


This statement is based on written information given by Voipac's suppliers, component manufacturers' own certification and is accurate to the best of our knowledge.
